Since its first edition in 2004, SteelFab has gone from strength-to-strength. The last show in January 2010 attracted 6014 trade visitors. Of the total, visitors from the Gulf Co-operation Council (GCC) states posted a 7.5% increase in numbers, with Saudi Arabia alone seeing a surge of 30%. From nearby markets, visitors came from India, Pakistan, Central Asia and North Africa. Around 190 exhibitors participated, filling 16,000 sq m (gross) of floor space.

Endowed with huge natural resources and supported by government measures, the Middle East's regional economies weathered the economic slump of 2009 and are now on track for growth. Right from budgetary allocations to easing of bank lending and scrapping of minimum capital for setting up businesses, the UAE took every possible measure to revive its local economy and the results are seen in the form of newly revived construction and infrastructure projects, an increase in industrial manufacturing and other businesses activities. This augurs well for the metalworking industry in the form of bigger and better orders for equipment, machinery and tools.

MTI will in fact be hosting its established • MTI Pavilion• at SteelFab, and a number of leading used machine tool dealers have already signed up to participate. Among their number is C. Dugard (UK), Electromotion (UK), Perfection Machinery (USA) and Enterprise Machinery (UK).
